**WORKSHOP MINUTES**

Tremont Borough Council held a Workshop at 6:30 p.m. in Clay Street's Municipal Building.

Carpet bids for the Tilghman Medical Center were received from McNulty (\$3,290.00), Snyder (\$3,750.00) and Reliable Home Supply (\$2,734.00). Motion made by Kintzel, second by Adams to approve Reliable Home Supply to install the carpet at the Tilghman Medical Center. Roll call vote; all in favor.

Motion made by Adams, second by Donmoyer to allow CEO Fasnacht to bid on the 39 Crescent Street property that is up for bid at a Judicial Sale. Roll call vote; all in favor.

There were two Quality of Life Appeals presented to Council:

1. 9 South Pine Street - Ticket # 348 in the amount of \$50.00 for Violation # QOL-001; Appeal Rejected.

Motion made by Kintzel, second by Adams to reject the appeal of Ticket #348, but reduce fine to \$25.00. Roll call vote; all in favor.

2. 242 West Line Street – Ticket # 344 in the amount of \$200.00 for Violation # QOL-001 and QOL-006; Appeal Rejected.

Motion made by Kintzel, second by Adams to reject the appeal of Ticket #344, but reduce fine to \$25.00 per violation. Roll call vote; all in favor.
